By purchasing a lesson or a lesson package the student agrees to following:

- 1. Lessons are generally 45 minutes long. The length of the lessons can vary at the discretion of the instructor depending on the riders' and horses' needs.
- 2. Purchase of lesson package required to keep weekly lesson spot.
- 3. Single lessons are valid for 1 month after purchase, non-refundable and charged at actual participation of lesson.
- 4. Lesson packages are valid for 6 months after date of purchase & non-refundable.
- 5. No-shows or cancellations after 9:00pm the previous day will be charged in full.
- 6. Lessons start promptly. Late students may join the lesson if approved by the trainer or are charged the full amount.
- 7. We reserve the right to cancel lessons due to weather, road conditions or other reasons affecting the safety of the students. We will do our best to do so in a timely matter. There will be no charge for cancellations by Tamangur,
- 8. Rescheduling missed lessons or cancellations is up to the discretion and availability of Tamangur.
- 9. We reserve the right to cancel a steady lesson spot at the end of a lesson package for unreliable students.
- 10. Helmets, ankle high boots and long pants as well as seasonal clothing required. We reserve the right to deny lessons to insufficiently dressed students.
- 11. Please arrive 20-30 minutes before the lesson. The student should be tacked up & ready by scheduled lesson start.
- 12. Allow for enough time after the lesson to take care of the lesson horse.
- 13. By purchasing a lesson or lesson package you agree to and confirm having read the Barn Rules (see Barn Rules).

Basic Care includes care, run with shelter, hay, water, up to 2 pounds of Maintenance Feed or Senior per day, sunflower seeds, salt and mineral block. Use of arena, track and access to pasture (managed by Tamangur, turnout depending on weather and grass situation) included.

Extra Care includes Basic Care as well as shavings, blanketing, turnout and up to 2 feedings of supplements/feed (supplement and special feed provided by owner).

A discount of \$25 applies for the 2nd boarded horse per household, an additional discount per horse of \$25 for owners of 3+ horses. Maximum discount \$50 per horse.

Additional services can be purchased at an extra charge.

By paying the Boarding Fee the boarder agrees to following:

- 1. Boarding Fees due before the 1st of each month.
- 2. Any late payment shall be assessed a late fee of 10%, provided that payment in full is received by the 10th day of the month. This late fee shall increase to 30% if payment is made after the 10th day of the month.
- 3. It is the responsibility of the owner to provide or arrange for any care outside of the paid Board. Tamangur is available at the request of the owner (see extra charges). Please fill out Additional/Change Care Request and submit it to Tamangur.
- 4. Tamangur follows worming practices recommended by leading parasitologists. Horses will be checked for worms by fecal exam every other year and dewormed in the spring and fall. Cost for worming & fecal test is to be covered by Owner.
- 5. New and resident horses are required to be up to date on Tetanus, East and West Encephalomyelitis, West Nile and Flu/Rhino as well as Rabies vaccine. New horses are required to have a current Coggins. It is recommended for resident horses to have a current Coggins.
- 6. Tamangur organizes health checks and vaccination rounds in the spring and fall. There will be no charge for catching and handling during these vet appointments. Cost of vaccines and tests to be covered by Owner.
- 7. Tamangur offers sunflower seeds as part of the board to help with digestion and sand in the horses' systems. We recommend feeding the seeds or treating the horses regularly with Psyllium. Refer to your veterinarian for details.
- 8. Keep Tamangur informed in writing about all treatments, injuries & illnesses treated by a veterinarian.
- 9. Initial emergency care will be provided by Tamangur at Emergency Rate. Owner is expected to continue care as soon as possible. If Owner is unavailable, see rates below for continued care.

By agreeing to lease out a horse to Tamangur for Use in Lessons the boarder agrees to following:

- 1. Tamangur receives access to the horse on predefined days.
- 2. Owner gets reimbursed for every occurred Use in Lessons in form of credit at the end of each month. Credit will be applied to the board in second month. Tamangur will keep a log of Uses in Lessons.

By paying the Training Fee the owner agrees to following:

- 1. Training Fees due before the 1st of each month.
- 2. Training is only provided for on-site horses. The exception are single training sessions.
- 3. Horses are generally ridden the defined number of sessions a month, but this is not guaranteed. Occasional, well-timed days off can be an important part of training. If a horse is not ridden due to trainer unavailability, those days will be pro-rated.
- 4. The length of the training session might vary depending on the horse's needs.
- 5. While the horse is getting trained, it is the Owner's responsibility to improve his/her knowledge and stay informed. Only with an involved owner can the training have its full success.
- 6. Our training sessions consist of handling, groundwork and riding, all aimed at making the horse more knowledgeable, confident, physically and mentally balanced.
- 7. Full Training includes holding for the farrier.
